

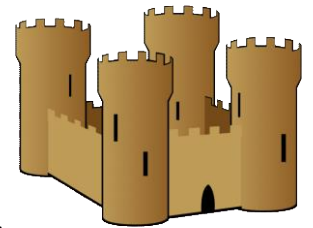


## Butterfly Class News

Dear Parents,

26th January 2018

This week we came to the end of the story *The Kiss that Missed* and the children really enjoyed the story and illustrations. Next week we begin reading *George and the Dragon*, however this time *George* is a mouse. We shall use the story writing skills learned over the last three weeks to make this next story our own. We will be using 2D shapes in both maths and art. We shall begin to study the work of Paul Klee and his picture *Castle and Sun*.



Activities to do at home to support your child's learning could include:

- Find out about Saint *George*, the Patron Saint of England
- Read alternative versions of familiar stories, for example  
*The Three Wolves and The Big Bad Pig* - Eugene Trivizas  
*The True Story of The Three Little Pigs* - Jon Scieszka  
*Jack and the Baked Beanstalk* - Colin Stimpson  
*The Great Fairytale Disaster* - David Conway
- Find and name 2D shapes - cut out 2D shapes and make them into pictures
- Share out objects, for example a group of toys, raisins or 1p coins fairly and equally between 2, 3, 4 or 5 people so each person has the same amount
- Year 1 children count in 2's, 5's and 10's to 100. Use the hundreds square as a support if needed.
